

Woman Perfects Voting Machine.
Columbus, O., Aug. 21.—Mrs. Belle C. Gatrell, a Columbus woman, has perfected a voting machine. She presented the machine at the office of the secretary of state for formal approval for use in this state. The machine was invented by the husband of Mrs. Gatrell, Ottmar Gatrell, who died six years ago before his invention was completed. Mrs. Gatrell took the machine up where her husband left it, and believes that she has made one of the best machines yet produced. Owing to the absence of the governor, who is a member of the commission to pass upon such devices, the examination was postponed.
